Release of the autopsy, Medical Examiner's reports, and other pertinent records that are under the purview of the commission — all of which will provide more insight regarding the circumstances that led to Kevin Desir's death while under the supervision of the Broward Sheriff's Office (BSO). BSO conducts internal investigations without any oversight in use of force cases, with Kevin Desir being one of many examples Greater transparency as it pertains to BSO investigations and corrective actions — with stonewalling the release of information and videos that reveal the cause of Kevin Desir's death being a primary example.

Kevin Desir was arrested for possession of cannabis in January 2021. He was detained by the Broward Sheriff's Office. While in the North Broward Bureau, Kevin experienced a mental health crisis. Although officers were aware of his condition, they restrained, tased, and brutally beat Kevin. The officers denied the on-duty health teams access to him. He was then transferred to the hospital, where he later died due to brain injuries sustained during the beating.

Since then, BSO has done everything in its power to bury the truth about this case. They have refused to release video footage of the event, the autopsy, and Medical Examiner's reports - while completely ignoring the Desir family.

Additionally, BSO is in charge of investigating themselves. As such, there is no objective, internal mechanism to reveal incidents of abuse, misconduct and neglect. Kevin Desir is just one example of the pervasive culture of abuse and violence in the Broward County Corrections system.

We request the commission add to the agenda these demands of BSO

The Medical Examiner's Office release the autopsy, report and other information within its purview that will provide insight regarding the circumstances that led to the death of Kevin Desir

That the commission pass a resolution that acknowledges that release of the video and records be declared a matter of great public importance
