

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
3 COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO RATES, FEES, AND CHARGES AT FORT
4 LAUDERDALE-HOLLYWOOD INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT; AMENDING
5 SECTION 39.2 AND EXHIBIT 39.A OF THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE
6 CODE ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE") TO REFLECT CHANGES TO RATES, FEES, AND
7 CHARGES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE
8 ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 WHEREAS, as required by Section 2-3 of the Broward County Code of
11 Ordinances, the Broward County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") establishes,
12 through the adoption of a Resolution, the rates, fees, and charges for the services and
13 facilities provided at Broward County's Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport
14 ("Airport");

15 WHEREAS, the rates, fees, and charges for services and facilities at the Airport
16 are included in Chapter 39 of the Broward County Administrative Code; and

17 WHEREAS, the Board desires to amend certain provisions of Chapter 39 in order
18 to revise the schedule of rates, fees, and charges, NOW, THEREFORE,

19 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
20 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

21 Section 1. Section 39.2 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby
22 amended to read as follows:

23 **39.2. Rates, Fees, and Charges—Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport.**

37 (a) Rate of one dollar and ~~fifty-seven cents (\$1.57)~~ seventy-six
38 cents (\$1.76) per one thousand (1,000) pounds of nominal
39 gross landed weight, as determined by the Aviation
40 Department, for each revenue arrival. (A revenue arrival is an
41 arriving plane that generates business from that arrival or
42 departure from the airport.)

44 2. Non-Wholly Owned Affiliated Airlines:
45 (a) Rate of ~~one dollar and eighty-nine cents (\$1.89)~~ two dollars
46 and eleven cents (\$2.11) per one thousand (1,000) pounds of
47 nominal gross landed weight, as determined by the Aviation
48 Department, for each revenue arrival. (A revenue arrival is an
49 arriving plane that generates business from that arrival or
50 departure from the airport.)

52 3. All Others:
53 (a) Rate of two dollars and ~~five cents (\$2.05)~~ twenty-nine cents
54 (\$2.29) per one thousand (1,000) pounds of nominal gross
55 landed weight, as determined by the Aviation Department, for
56 each revenue and non-revenue arrival by a plane.

95 **III. FACILITY USE CHARGE**

96 A Facility Use Charge of ~~eleven dollars and twenty cents (\$11.20)~~ twelve dollars
 97 and thirty cents (\$12.30) per deplaning passenger is hereby established for
 98 incoming international flights utilizing the federal inspection station for taking on or
 99 discharging passengers.

103 (5) All passenger check-in facilities must be reserved in advance, with the approval of
 104 the Aviation Department. Passenger check-in facilities charges shall be applied at
 105 the rate of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per hour, or any part thereof, for Signatory

106 Carriers, and ~~thirty-three dollars (\$33.00)~~ thirty-two dollars (\$32.00) per hour, or
107 any part thereof, for all other carriers, per ticket counter position for any passenger
108 check-in facility reserved, whether utilized or not. Signatory Carriers will not be
109 charged, on a monthly basis, for per use passenger check-in facilities in an amount
110 greater than would otherwise be charged to that carrier for a monthly preferential
111 lease of equivalent ticket counter space.

113 (8) Signatory Carriers using a per use gate shall not be charged more than the
114 following amounts for Gate Charges for that gate, per month:
