2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
3 COUNTY, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING A DONATION FROM BROWARD PUBLIC LIBRARY
4 FOUNDATION, INC., OF TOUCHSCREEN TABLETS, KEYBOARDS, AND INTERNET
5 DATA PLANS, VALUED AT \$114,414.98, FOR THE WORKFORCE READY INITIATIVE;
6 AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ANY NECESSARY
7 ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR
8 SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 WHEREAS, Broward Public Library Foundation, Inc. ("Foundation") has most
11 generously offered to donate touchscreen tablets, keyboards, and internet data plans to
12 the Libraries Division, with a total value of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Four
13 Hundred Fourteen and 98/100 Dollars (\$114,414.98), for the Library Division's Workforce
14 Ready Initiative;

15 WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code requires
16 that donations to Broward County valued at Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) or more
17 must be accepted by a resolution of the Board of County Commissioners ("Board"); and

18 WHEREAS, the Board wishes to accept the generous donation and express its
19 gratitude for such donation, NOW, THEREFORE,

20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
21 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

22 Section 1. The Board hereby accepts the donation of touchscreen tablets,
23 keyboards, and internet data plans, with a total value of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand
24 Four Hundred Fourteen and 98/100 Dollars (\$114,414.98), from Broward Public Library
25 Foundation, Inc., located at 100 S. Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301.

26 Section 2. The donated items will be used for the Library Division's Workforce
27 Ready Initiative.

28 Section 3. The County Administrator is hereby authorized to take all
29 administrative and budgetary actions and execute all forms required to accept the
30 donation in accordance with the purposes stated in this Resolution.

31 Section 4. Severability.

32 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
33 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
34 Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be
35 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
36 determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,
37 group, entity, property, or circumstance.
