2 AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD  
3 COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO THE REPEAL OF OBSOLETE OR OUTDATED  
4 PROVISIONS IN CHAPTER 1 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES  
5 (“CODE”); REPEALING SECTION 1-6 RELATING TO THE PURCHASE OF UNIFORMS  
6 FOR CERTAIN BROWARD COUNTY EMPLOYEES, SECTION 1-8 RELATING TO  
7 PUBLIC INFORMATION ON THE ENERGY CRISIS, SECTION 1-12 RELATING TO  
8 ELECTRONIC ACCESS TO PUBLIC RECORDS, SECTION 1-20 RELATING TO THE  
9 EXECUTION OF AGREEMENTS WITH SECOND PARTIES, SECTION 1-21 RELATING  
10 TO THE TIME LIMITATION ON BRINGING MATTERS BEFORE THE BOARD OF  
11 COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND SECTION 1-46 RELATING TO INDEMNIFICATION  
12 CLAUSES IN FEDERAL PROJECT CONTRACTS; AND PROVIDING FOR  
13 SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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16 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
17 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

18 Section 1. Section 1-6 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, entitled  
19 “Purchase of uniforms by county for certain employees,” is hereby repealed in its entirety.

20 Section 2. Section 1-8 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, entitled  
21 “Expenditures and budgeting for purpose of public information on energy crisis,” is hereby  
22 repealed in its entirety.

23           Section 3.    Section 1-12 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, entitled  
24 "Electronic access to public records," is hereby repealed in its entirety.

25           Section 4.    Section 1-20 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, entitled  
26 "Execution by commission of agreements with second parties," is hereby repealed in its  
27 entirety.

28           Section 5.    Section 1-21 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, entitled  
29 "Time limitation on bringing matters before the board of county commissioners," is hereby  
30 repealed in its entirety.

31           Section 6.    Section 1-46 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, entitled  
32 "Indemnification clauses in federal project contracts, etc.," is hereby repealed in its  
33 entirety.

34           Section 7.    Severability.

35           If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid  
36 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this  
37 Ordinance. If any court determines that this Ordinance, in whole or in part, cannot be  
38 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such  
39 determination will not affect the applicability of this Ordinance to any other individual,  
40 group, entity, property, or circumstance.

41           Section 8.    Inclusion in the Broward County Code of Ordinances.

42           It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this  
43 Ordinance become part of the Broward County Code of Ordinances as of the effective  
44 date. The sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word

45 “ordinance” may be changed to “section,” “article,” or such other appropriate word or  
46 phrase to the extent necessary in order to accomplish such intention.

47 Section 9. Effective Date.

48 This Ordinance is effective as of the date provided by law.
