except where inconsistent with the Broward County Charter, general or special law, or the enabling enactments of such advisory boards or other boards, shall be subject to the following requirements:

26 .

(g) <u>Unless otherwise required by Florida law,</u> The number of members needed to constitute a quorum on any advisory or other board shall be a majority of the total appointed board members, provided that either the presiding member or at least three (3) members are physically present at the meeting. Except as provided in Section 1-233(g)(1), once a quorum has been established by if either the presiding member or at least three (3) members who are physically present at a meeting, members who are not physically present may attend and participate in a the meeting by using communications media technology ("CMT"), such as telephonic or video conferencing or other electronic transmission of audio, video, or printed matter.

## Section 2. Severability.

If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance. If any court determines that this Ordinance, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Ordinance to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.
