2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 SUPPORTING THE BROWARD METROPOLITAN PLANNING
5 ORGANIZATION'S MOBILITY PROJECT TO ENHANCE
6 BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN SAFETY ALONG NW 19TH
7 STREET FROM NW 49TH AVENUE TO SR-7; RECOGNIZING
8 THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AS
9 THE AGENCY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DESIGN,
10 CONSTRUCTION, AND CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION;
11 AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE
12 DATE.

13 WHEREAS, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("MPO") has funds
14 under its Transportation Improvement Program to design and construct bicycle lanes and
15 sidewalks along NW 19th Street from NW 49th Avenue to SR-7, within the City of Lauderhill
16 ("City"), under Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") Financial Project ID
17 429576-7 ("Project" or "Project Improvements");

18 WHEREAS, the Project is on the MPO priority list as identified in the SR-7
19 Multimodal Improvement Corridor Study completed July 2016;

20 WHEREAS, the road right-of-way within the limits of the Project is functionally
21 classified as a Broward County ("County") road, which requires the County to operate and
22 maintain the road right-of-way;

23 WHEREAS, the MPO collaborated with the Broward County Highway Construction
24 and Engineering Division, City, and FDOT to develop the Project;

WHEREAS, the MPO and FDOT require a resolution from the County supporting
the Project;

WHEREAS, the Project will further the County's complete streets efforts while
furthering the County's goal to "support the development, design, and construction of

1 sustainable, multi-modal transportation facilities throughout the County, to meet the
2 demands of residents, travelers, and businesses";

3 WHEREAS, FDOT will be the agency responsible for the design, construction, and
4 construction administration of the Project; and

5 WHEREAS, FDOT's design, construction, and construction administration for the
6 Project must meet or exceed the "Minimum Standards Applicable to Public Rights-of-Way
7 Under Broward County Jurisdiction," Section 25.1, Exhibit 25.A, of the Broward County
8 Administrative Code, NOW, THEREFORE,

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10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMISSIONERS OF
11 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

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13 Section 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed
14 as being true and correct and are made part of this Resolution.

15 Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida
16 ("Board"), supports the Project, which will improve conditions for bicyclists and
17 pedestrians along NW 19th Street from NW 49th Avenue to SR-7 within the Project.

18 Section 3. The Board supports FDOT as the agency responsible for the
19 Project's design, construction, and construction administration.

20 Section 4. County will continue operation and maintenance of the Project
21 Improvements within its right-of-way.

22 Section 5. Severability.

23 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the invalid
24 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
