THE RESILIENT ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT AND THE URBAN PLANNING DIVISION RECOMMEND APPROVAL OF THE ABOVE MOTION, subject to staff recommendations and

conditions.

This plat is located on 2.7 acres on the east side of South Flamingo Road between Pembroke Road and Pines Boulevard, in the City of Pembroke Pines. The applicant is requesting to amend an existing 60-foot wide access opening centered 230 feet north of Tract C-2, and replace it with a 36-foot opening with centerline located approximately 232 feet north of the northern end of the corner chord, this new opening will be restricted to right turn in only.
