THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT AND THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT MANAGEMENT DIVISION RECOMMEND APPROVAL OF THE ABOVE MOTION, subject to staff recommendations and conditions.

This plat is located on 0.78 acres on southeast corner of Northeast 8<sup>th</sup> Street and North Dixie Highway, in the City of Pompano Beach. The applicant is requesting a 24-foot-wide opening with centerline located approximately 18 feet east of the west plat limits along NE 8 Street. The existing non-vehicular access line along the railroad right-of-way will remain.
