#### Previous Action Taken

The Board appropriated \$3,108,007 in the BSO Department of Detention reserve for inmate inpatient care costs as part of the Fiscal Year 2022 1<sup>st</sup> supplemental budget approved on December 14, 2021. On January 25, 2022, the Board approved Budget Resolution No. 2022-035 which transferred \$1,277,000 from the BSO Department of Detention reserve to the Department of Detention operating budget to pay invoices for inmate inpatient care costs.
