Summary Explanation/Background

THE HUMAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT AND THE COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS DIVISION RECOMMEND APPROVAL OF THE ABOVE MOTION.

This action supports the Commission's value of "building partnerships and working collaboratively with others to meet shared objectives" and the goal of "delivering accessible human services that holistically address the whole person collaboratively and compassionately." This action also ensures the Broward County HIV Health Services Planning Council's ("Council") compliance with the U.S. Health Resources and Services Administration HIV/AIDS Bureau ("HRSA HAB") memorandum to establish Council members' term limits and rotations (Exhibit 2). The HRSA HAB guidelines are intended to encourage planning council membership to reflect the demographics of the individuals with HIV/AIDS within the jurisdictions of the various planning councils.

Section 1-233, Broward County Code of Ordinances ("Code"), provides general provisions for appointments to advisory boards, committees, councils, and task forces established by a Broward County ordinance or resolution. Section 1-233(a)(1) of the Code specifies that an appointment to an advisory board for a fixed term expires on the last day of the fixed term unless the appointee is removed for cause under federal, state, or local law, as applicable.

Chapter 12, Part X, Broward County Administrative Code, establishes the Council. Section 12.109, Broward County Administrative Code, states the terms of Council members will be in accordance with Section 1-233 of the Code. The requested amendment specifies the Council members' term limits and membership rotations.
