#### **Requested Action**

**MOTION TO APPROVE** Revocable License Agreement with the City of Sunrise ("City"), granting the City nonexclusive access and use of County property to construct improvements at the Dan Pearl Library located in the City, in substantially the form as Exhibit 1; and authorize the County Administrator to execute the Revocable License Agreement with any required modifications, provided such modifications do not impose any additional material risk on the County, and subject to review and approval as to legal sufficiency by the Office of the County Attorney. **(Commission District 9)**
