B. <u>MOTION TO APPROVE</u> First Amendment to System and Services Agreement between Broward County and Destiny Software, Inc., for AgendaQuick software maintenance and support services, to extend the Agreement for up to five additional one-year terms, through September 30, 2027, to be exercised by the Director of Purchasing, and increasing the total not-to-exceed amount by \$29,500 to \$65,200; and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to execute same.

Motion B: Extends the term of the Agreement for up to five additional one-year terms and increases the total not-to-exceed amount by \$29,500.

On September 26, 2017, the Director of Purchasing approved the System and Services Agreement to provide ongoing support and maintenance for the AgendaQuick software.

Motion A seeks to reaffirm the designation of Destiny Software, Inc. as the only reasonable source to provide continued maintenance and support services for the AgendaQuick software (Exhibit 1).
