

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD  
3 COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO PORT EVERGLADES TARIFF NO. 12;  
4 AMENDING SECTION 42.25 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE  
5 (“ADMINISTRATIVE CODE”); AMENDING TARIFF RATES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR  
6 VARIOUS ACTIVITIES AT PORT EVERGLADES; PROVIDING FOR GENERAL  
7 UPDATES TO TARIFF TEXT; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN  
8 THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County (“Board”)  
11 desires to amend Section 42.25 of the Broward County Administrative Code, Exhibit 42.A,  
12 to provide for revisions to Port Everglades Tariff No. 12 items relating to Port Everglades;

13 WHEREAS, the Board finds that the proposed revisions to Port Everglades Tariff  
14 No. 12 are in the best interest of Broward County, NOW, THEREFORE,

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
16 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

17 Section 1. Port Everglades Tariff No. 12, which is codified as Exhibit 42.A and  
18 incorporated in Section 42.25 of the Broward County Administrative Code, is hereby  
19 amended in relevant part as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto.

20 Section 2. Severability.

21 If any portion of this Administrative Code Resolution is determined by any court to  
22 be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity

23 of the remainder of this Administrative Code Resolution. If any court determines that this  
24 Administrative Code Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any  
25 individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the  
26 applicability of this Administrative Code Resolution to any other individual, group, entity,  
27 property, or circumstance.

28 Section 3. Inclusion in the Broward County Administrative Code.

29 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this  
30 Administrative Code Resolution become part of the Broward County Administrative Code  
31 as of the effective date. The sections of this Administrative Code Resolution may be  
32 renumbered or relettered and the word "resolution" may be changed to "section," "article,"  
33 or such other appropriate word or phrase to the extent necessary in order to accomplish  
34 such intention.

35 Section 4. Effective Date.

36 This Administrative Code Resolution is effective upon adoption.
