RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO SOLID WASTE OPERATIONS; AMENDING SECTION 38.38 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE"), TO PRESCRIBE A REVISED SCHEDULE OF LANDFILL RATES; UPDATING LANGUAGE RELATING TO WASTE DELIVERED BY RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 38.38 of the Broward County Administrative Code ("Administrative Code") sets forth the rates schedule for the disposal of solid waste at the Broward County Landfill; and

WHEREAS, to modernize operations at the Broward County Landfill, to avoid operating deficits, and to fund future capital projects, the Broward County Board of County Commissioners desires to revise the rates stated therein, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 38.38 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

55 Administrative Code Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any
56 individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the
57 applicability of this Administrative Code Resolution to any other individual, group, entity,
58 property, or circumstance.

59 Section 3. Inclusion in the Broward County Administrative Code.

60 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this
61 Administrative Code Resolution become part of the Broward County Administrative Code
62 as of the effective date. The sections of this Administrative Code Resolution may be
63 renumbered or relettered and the word "resolution" may be changed to "section," "article,"
64 or such other appropriate word or phrase to the extent necessary in order to accomplish
65 such intention.
