

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO
PUBLISH NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER
ENACTMENT OF AN ORDINANCE

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County,
Florida, that:

Section 1. The County Administrator in and for Broward County, Florida, and
ex officio Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County is authorized
and directed to publish notice of intent of the Board of County Commissioners of Broward
County to consider at public hearing on September 20, 2022, at 10:00 a.m., the enactment
of an Ordinance, the title of which is as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
COUNTY, FLORIDA ("BOARD"), PERTAINING TO ANTISEMITISM; AMENDING
ARTICLE IV OF CHAPTER 21 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES
("CODE"); PROVIDING FOR DEFINITIONS AND ESTABLISHING THE BOARD'S
INTENT THAT THE DEFINITION OF BIAS-MOTIVATED CRIMES AND ANTISEMITISM
BE CONSIDERED IN ENFORCING LAWS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY,
INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Section 2. Such notice shall be made pursuant to the applicable provisions
of Section 125.66, Florida Statutes.
