

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD  
3 COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO WATER AND WASTEWATER SERVICES;  
4 AMENDING SECTION 38.19 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE  
5 ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE") TO PRESCRIBE A REVISED SCHEDULE OF RAW  
6 WATER SUPPLY LARGE USER RATES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY,  
7 INCLUSION IN THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN  
8 EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 WHEREAS, Broward County provides raw water supply to large users of the  
11 County's Regional Raw Water System pursuant to certain Agreements (the  
12 "Agreements");

13 WHEREAS, the Agreements require that Broward County review the rates on an  
14 annual basis, and Broward County has completed its review accordingly;

15 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34-6 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances,  
16 the water and wastewater rates, fees, and charges are required to be established  
17 following public notice and hearing, which, in this matter, have been satisfied; and

18 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds it is reasonable and in the  
19 best interest of the public to revise Section 38.19 of the Broward County Administrative  
20 Code to reflect the new rates, fees, and charges for large users of the Regional Raw  
21 Water System effective with all services rendered on or after October 1, 2022, NOW,  
22 THEREFORE,

23 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
24 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

25 Section 1. The recitals set forth in the preamble to this Resolution are  
26 incorporated by reference herein.

27 Section 2. Section 38.19 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby  
28 amended to read as follows:

29 **38.19. Raw Water Supply Large User Rates.**

30 The following schedule of rates, fees, and charges for Large Users of the Regional  
31 Raw Water System operated by Broward County Water and Wastewater Services is  
32 effective with all services rendered on or after October 1, ~~2021~~ 2022:

33	a.	Customer Charge (per account, per month) .....	<del>\$5.02</del>	<u>\$5.10</u>
34	b.	Operations and Maintenance		
35		(per one thousand (1,000) gallons, all gallons) .....	<del>0.229</del>	<u>\$0.241</u>
36	c.	Monthly Improvement, Repair, and Replacement
