SUBJECT: Fiscal Impact Statement Re: Proposed Ordinance Amending Chapter 2 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, Relating to Peer-to-Peer Car Sharing Services

Summary

The proposal amends Chapter 2 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, Relating to Peer-to-Peer Car Sharing Services. Section 2-111 would be amended to further clarify that Off-Airport Motor Vehicle Rental Operators are persons or entities that provide any motor vehicle rental service, including the facilitation or peer-to-peer car sharing and what constitutes the such. The amendments also provide clarifying information on how individuals or entities desiring to provide a motor vehicle rental service shall apply in order to obtain permits.

Fiscal Impact

Under the proposed ordinance, Chapter 2 would be amended to include clarifying language relating to peer-to-peer car sharing services, as well as requiring individuals and entities that would like to provide this service to obtain a permit from the Broward County Aviation Department. Based on figures provided by the Broward County Aviation Department on the estimated number of daily rentals, average daily costs, and average days per rental transaction for peer-to-peer car sharing services the changes to this ordinance may result in an estimated \$100,000 in additional revenue annually resulting from the 10% privilege fee the agency would collect from service providers.
