11	WHEREAS, Jews are consistently one of the most targeted religious communities
12	in the United States;
13	WHEREAS, Jewish institutions, such as synagogues, Jewish community centers,
14	and Jewish schools, are also the targets of antisemitic incidents, including vandalism,
15	harassment, assaults, and deadly violence;
16	WHEREAS, antisemitic incidents are being reported at record levels;
17	WHEREAS, Jews are regularly targeted because of their actual or perceived
18	support for Israel and Zionism;
