RESOLUTION NO. R-1124-20

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO RECOGNIZE AND DESIGNATE JUNETEENTH AS A PAID COUNTY HOLIDAY TO BE OBSERVED ON JUNE 19 OF EACH YEAR FOR NON-BARGAINING EMPLOYEES AND ALL OTHER EMPLOYEES COVERED BY COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS WHOSE AGREEMENTS PROVIDE FOR THIS HOLIDAY

WHEREAS, Juneteenth commemorates the declaration of the abolition of slavery, which occurred in Galveston, Texas on June 19, 1865; and

WHEREAS, although President Abraham Lincoln's Emancipation Proclamation became effective January 1, 1863 and the Civil War ended on April 9, 1865, Texas remained rebellious following the end of the Civil War; and

WHEREAS, Juneteenth recognizes the day all remaining slaves were freed; and

WHEREAS, many communities and organizations nationwide celebrate Juneteenth on June 19 of each year; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to join those communities in recognizing and commemorating Juneteenth as it is a celebration of liberation and achievement for African Americans and the entire country,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to recognize and designate Juneteenth as a paid County holiday to be observed on June 19 of each year for non-bargaining employees and all other

employees covered by collective bargaining agreements whose agreements provide for this holiday. In the event June 19 is on a Saturday or Sunday in any given year, the paid County holiday shall be observed on the following business day.
