2	A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3	COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT; ADODTING THE 2020 BROWARD COUNTY
4	ADOPTING THE 2020 BROWARD COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN
5	EFFECTIVE DATE.

7	WHEREAS, Chapter 27P-6 of the Florida Administrative Code, entitled "Review of
8	Local Emergency Management Plans," sets forth the requirements, format, and standards
9	for the development and maintenance of a County Comprehensive Emergency
10	Management Plan ("CEMP");
11	WHEREAS, Rule 27P-6.0023 of the Florida Administrative Code requires each
12	county to develop a CEMP, which is subject to review every four (4) years;
13	WHEREAS, the Florida Division of Emergency Management ("FDEM") has
14	completed its review of the proposed 2020 Broward County CEMP and determined that
15	it complies with the applicable requirements and criteria;
16	WHEREAS, pursuant to Rule 27P-6.006(11) of the Florida Administrative Code,
17	within ninety (90) days after the FDEM determines that a proposed CEMP complies with
18	the applicable requirements and criteria, the approved plan must be adopted by resolution
19	of the governing body; and
20	WHEREAS, upon adoption of the approved plan by the governing body, a copy of
21	the adopted resolution and an electronic copy of the approved plan must be provided to
22	the FDEM, NOW, THEREFORE,
23	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
24	BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1	Section 1. The 2020 Broward County Comprehensive Emergency Management
2	Plan is hereby adopted.
3	Section 2. <u>Severability</u> .
4	If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
5	portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
6	Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be
7	legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
8	determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,
9	group, entity, property, or circumstance.
10	Section 3. Effective Date.
11	This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
