1 **RESOLUTION NO. 2020-**2 RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY 3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA. PERTAINING TO RATES, FEES, AND CHARGES AT FORT 4 LAUDERDALE-HOLLYWOOD INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT: AMENDING SECTION 39.2 AND EXHIBIT 39.A OF THE 5 BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE") , TO REFLECT CHANGES TO 6 RATES, FEES, AND CHARGES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE 7 CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 8 9 WHEREAS, as required by Section 2-3 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, the Broward County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") fixes and 10 establishes, through the adoption of a resolution, the rates, fees, and charges for the 11 12 services and facilities provided at Broward County's Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood 13 International Airport; 14 WHEREAS, the rates, fees, and charges established by resolution are included in 15 Chapter 39 of the Broward County Administrative Code; and 16 WHEREAS, the Board desires to amend certain provisions of Chapter 39 in order 17 to revise the schedule of rates, fees, and charges, NOW, THEREFORE, 18 19 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF 20 **BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:** 21 Section 1. Section 39.2 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby 22 amended to read as follows: 23 39.2. Rates, Fees, and Charges—Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International 24 Airport. 16		counter position for any passenger check-in facility reserved, whether utilized or				
17		not. Signatory Carriers will not be charged, on a monthly basis, for per use				
18		passenger check-in facilities in an amount greater than would otherwise be				
19		charged to that carrier for a monthly preferential lease of equivalent ticket counter
