2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,  
4 ACCEPTING A DONATION IN THE AMOUNT OF TEN  
5 THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000) FROM JOAN FISHER, TO  
6 BE DEPOSITED IN THE ANIMAL CARE ADOPTION TRUST  
7 FUND FOR THE FUNDING OF LIFESAVING PROGRAMS;  
8 AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE  
9 ALL ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS TO  
10 IMPLEMENT ACCEPTANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR  
11 SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

12 WHEREAS, Joan Fisher has donated to the Animal Care and Adoption Division  
13 the amount of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), to be used for the funding of lifesaving  
14 programs;

15 WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code provides  
16 for the acceptance and acknowledgement by the Board of County Commissioners of  
17 Broward County, Florida ("Board"), of donations to the County that are valued at Ten  
18 Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) or more; and

19 WHEREAS, the Board wishes to accept the generous gift and express its gratitude  
20 for the donation, NOW, THEREFORE,

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
22 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

23 Section 1. The Board hereby accepts the donation from Joan Fisher in the  
24 amount of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), to be deposited in the Animal Care Trust  
Fund and used for the funding of lifesaving programs of the Animal Care and Adoption  
Division.

1 Section 2. The County Administrator is hereby authorized to take all  
2 administrative and budgetary actions and execute all forms required to implement  
3 acceptance of the donation.

4 Section 3. SEVERABILITY.

5 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any Court to be invalid, the invalid  
6 portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the remainder of  
7 this Resolution. If any Court determines that this Resolution, or any portion hereof, cannot  
8 be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such  
9 determination shall not affect the applicability hereof to any other individual, group, entity,  
10 property, or circumstance.

11 Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

12 This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
