3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 ACCEPTING A DONATION OF \$25,000 FROM SIEBERT
5 CISNEROS SHANK & CO., LLC TO BE UTILIZED FOR THE
6 PURPOSE OF ASSISTING CERTAIN ORGANIZATIONS IN
7 BROWARD COUNTY; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY
8 ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL ADMINISTRATIVE AND
9 BUDGETARY ACTIONS REQUIRED TO IMPLEMENT
10 ACCEPTANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND
11 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

13 WHEREAS, Siebert Cisneros Shank & Co, LLC (“Donor”) has agreed to donate
14 \$25,000 to Broward County to assist the County in its efforts to provide assistance to
15 certain organizations during the COVID-19 pandemic;

16 WHEREAS, Donor has informed that it would like the funds to be distributed evenly
17 among all entities to which District 9 is donating its excess budgeted funds;

18 WHEREAS, Section 18.63 of the Broward County Administrative Code provides
19 for the acceptance and acknowledgement by the Board of County Commissioners of
20 Broward County, Florida ("Board"), of donations to the County; and

21 WHEREAS, the Board wishes to accept the generous gift and to express its
22 gratitude for such donation, NOW, THEREFORE,

24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board hereby accepts a donation of \$25,000 from Siebert
Cisneros Shank & Co, LLC for the use and benefit of Broward County organizations to
which District 9 is donating its excess budgeted funds.

1 Section 2. The County Administrator is authorized to take all administrative and
2 budgetary actions required to implement acceptance of the donation in this matter.

3 Section 3. Severability.

4 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
5 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
6 Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be
7 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
8 determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,
9 group, entity, property, or circumstance.

10 Section 4. Effective Date.

11 This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
