RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY. FLORIDA. **PUBLIC** TRANSPORTATION APPROVING GRANT WITH AGREEMENT THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR FINANCIAL PROJECT NO. 447617-1-94-01 TO FUND THE AIRFIELD LIGHTING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT AT NORTH PERRY AIRPORT; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF SAME BY THE MAYOR OR VICE-MAYOR; **AUTHORIZING** COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE THE NECESSARY ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS, APPROVE ANY NONMONETARY AMENDMENTS SUBJECT TO THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY ATTORNEY **APPROVING** AS TO LEGAL SUFFICIENCY: PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") and Broward County ("County") desire to enter into a Public Transportation Grant Agreement for Financial Project No. 447617-1-94-01 ("PTGA") to fund the Airfield Lighting Improvements project at North Perry Airport ("Project"), as such Project is more fully described in the PTGA:

WHEREAS, the total cost of the Project is estimated to be Three Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$330,000) ("Project Cost");

WHEREAS, FDOT, pursuant to the PTGA, will fund eighty percent (80%) of the Project, up to a maximum amount of Two Hundred Sixty-four Thousand Dollars (\$264,000); and

WHEREAS, the County, pursuant to the PTGA, will accept FDOT's funding and fund all expenses for the Project in excess of the amount of FDOT's funding, currently estimated to be Sixty-six Thousand Dollars (\$66,000) or twenty percent (20%) of the Project, while continuing to cover any Project Cost overruns, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Broward County Board of County Commissioners hereby approves the PTGA between FDOT and the County, and authorizes the Mayor or Vice-Mayor to execute the PTGA (attached hereto), which provides that FDOT will fund eighty percent (80%) of the Project, up to a maximum amount of Two Hundred Sixty-four Thousand Dollars (\$264,000), and the County will fund all expenses for the Project in excess of the amount of FDOT's funding, currently estimated to be Sixty-six Thousand Dollars (\$66,000) or twenty percent (20%) of the Project, with the County continuing to cover any Project Cost overruns.

Section 2. The County Administrator is hereby authorized to take the necessary administrative and budgetary actions to implement the PTGA, and approve any nonmonetary amendments to the PTGA subject to the Office of the County Attorney approving as to legal sufficiency.

## Section 3. Severability.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.
