Anticipated Federal Funding Source: USDOT FTA (100%)

The Office of Economic and small Business Development has determined that this project is race-neutral and will not contain race-conscious contract goals.

Because this project is funded, in whole or in part by the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Transit Administration (FTA), this project is subject to the requirements of title 49 CFR Part 26. The County has established an overall Triennial DBE program goal of 19.13% for federally-funded transit projects.

In order for the Transit Division to receive credit for utilization of DBE firms on this project, participating firms must be certified according to USDOT requirements as a DBE. **This contract is not subject to the Broward County Workforce Investment Program.**
