Everglades (PEV). Contractor is responsible to ensure the complete functionality of all the Loading Bridge
including electronics, hydraulics, mechanical, fiber communication, electrical components, programming and
software operations and upgrades. Contractor is responsible to furnish all labor, materials, equipment, persona
protective equipment (PPE), tools, supervision, transportation, identification badges and all other incidental
as required to complete the work to the satisfaction of the Contract Administrator or Project Manager. Se

Reasons for the urgent need of a Most Reasonable Source Vendor:

- 1. The previous Port Everglades Sole Source/Sole Brand Loading Bridge Vendor FMT Aircraft Gate Support Systems (FMT), located in Sweden, is bankrupt and unable to meet the ongoing demanding need of Port Everglades Loading Bridge operations.
- 2. Port Everglades Loading Bridges are highly complex steel structures, driven by proprietary software, that must remain in constant working condition to be safely used by thousands of passengers embarking and debarking cruise vessels daily.
- 3. The repairs of any mechanical, electrical, structural, and/or programming of software malfunctions must be completed immediately. The proposed full service and experienced vendor is located in Miami, roughly 45 minutes to Port Everglades. The next available vendor is located in Cape Canaveral, over 3 hours away.
- 4. Port Everglades has a great need for augmenting Port staff in terms of technical expertise required for timely repairs and operations of the Loading Bridges. Current internal Port staffing levels are not sufficient to meet the maintenance needs of the Port and must be supplemented by local contract vendors.
- 5. Nine (9) of the loading bridges are over 15 years old and with the complexity of the programming needed, it has become more difficult to address repairs in a timely manner by in-house staff. Having a local vendor on board will ease routine maintenance and address timely emergency repairs for the Port, especially when addressing programing issues, which is an essential component to the proper functionality of the loading bridges.

Port Everglades Request :

following reasons:

- 1. The Port is requesting a reasonable source designation for SATE Solutions, Inc., located in Miami, Florida, to assist Port staff to maintain and repair the four MEGs and eleven Passenger Loading Bridges at Port Everglades for a minimum of one year term with a possible two, 1 year renewals.
- a. SATE Solutions, Inc. is a local vendor who has previously performed repair services at the Port for Terminals 4, 25, and 26 loading bridges.
- b. SATE Solutions, Inc. has teamed up with the software programmer, located in Sweden, that created the original program for the FMT bridges, which will be vital when addressing programing issues, and is an essential component to the proper functionality of the loading bridges. The software is a sophisticated and complicated program which would require a lengthy learning curve for other vendors to troubleshoot. With SATE Solutions, the expertise of the original programmer of the bridges will be available to assist in resolving the functionality issues of the 11 passenger loading bridges and 4 mobile elevated gangways.

- c. SATE Solutions, Inc. is a local vendor relied on by Port Miami to supplement their in-house personnel for their Seaport Loading Bridge repair needs.
 - d. SATE Solutions, Inc. would be responsible for:
- i. Providing repair and maintenance services for the eleven PLB's and the four MEG's located at Port Everglades.
- ii. Ensuring the complete functionality of all the Loading Bridges including electronics, hydraulics, mechanical, fiber communication, electrical components, programming and software operations upgrade.
- iii. Responsible to furnish all labor, materials, equipment, personal protective equipment (PPE), tools, supervision, transportation, identification badges and all other incidentals as required to complete the work to the satisfaction of the contract administrator or Project Manager.

- 2. During this contract period, Port staff will also be developing, within FY22, a longer term more comprehensive contract that will be recommended to bid to the open market to include renovations and technical upgrades to the PLB's and MEG's as well as preventive and routine maintenance and repairs that are the subject of this request.

SATE Solutions, Inc. has teamed up with the software programmer that created the original program for the FMT bridges, which will be vital when addressing programing issues, which is an essential component to the proper functionality of the loading bridges.

The software is a complicated program which would require a lengthy learning curve (thus additional costs) for other vendors to troubleshoot. SATE Solutions, will have the expertise of the original programmer of the bridges to assist in resolving the functionality issues of the 11 passenger loading bridges and 4 mobile elevated gangways.

The ramifications of using the next available vendor, located in Cape Canaveral over 3 hours away, will result in additional costs related to Contractor response times, and the vendor does not possess the programming capabilities to address the complex FMT software needs, thus resulting in delays to ship embarks/debarks. It is estimated that the travel costs for a two person crew round trip from Cape Canaveral to Port Everglades will add approximately \$1800 per call out event. No additional travel costs are anticipated with the proposed vendor is located within the Tri-County area.
