| 16 | Section 1. Section 18.5 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby | | |

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6. Delegation Requests. Any person shall be entitled to have a delegation request placed on the official agenda of a regular meeting of the County Commission provided the request is consistent with the conditions stated in this subsSection18.5.d.6. The delegation request must concern a matter within the scope of the County Commission's substantive jurisdiction, such that the County Commission can directly and materially affect the matter that the delegation request concerns.

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Any person who desires to speak to the County Commission (a) regarding a delegation request must properly and fully complete and return a delegation request form, to be provided by the County Administrator, no later than fifteen (15) days before the County Commission meeting at which the person desires to speak. The delegation request form must identify by name the person desiring to speak, must identify the particular topic on which the person desires to speak, and must include an affirmation that the particular topic is within the scope of the County Commission's substantive jurisdiction. The person may submit supplemental information with the delegation request form, which the County Administrator shall furnish to the County Commission if the delegation request is placed on the agenda. The person may also identify on the delegation request form up to two (2) other persons who desire to speak to the County Commission on the topic as part of the same delegation request.

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Section 2. Severability.

If any portion of this Administrative Code Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Administrative Code Resolution. If any court determines that this Administrative Code Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Administrative Code Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 3. Inclusion in the Broward County Administrative Code.

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this Administrative Code Resolution become part of the Broward County Administrative Code as of the effective date. The sections of this Administrative Code Resolution may be renumbered or relettered and the word "resolution" may be changed to "section," "article," or such other appropriate word or phrase to the extent necessary in order to accomplish such intention.
