MBR Construction, Inc., ENCO, LLC., FHP Tectonics Corp, West Construction, Inc. and Industrial Shadeports. provided the completed Contractor Assurance Statement as required in accordance with the solicitation. Therefore, they are compliant with the CBE program requirements of the solicitation. Once the projects are assigned and scopes of work are identified by the using agency; the recommended vendor(s) will be required to submit executed Letter(s) of Intent (LOI) for each certified CBE firm(s) to achieve the assigned 30% CBE goal on the contract.

Waypoint Contracting, Inc. and Emerald Construction Corp did not provide a completed Contractor Assurance Statement form with the bid submittals. The firms were given three (3) business days to provide a completed Contractor Assurance Statement form as required by the solicitation. Both firms submitted the completed forms within the allotted timeframe and therefore, are compliant with the CBE program requirements of the solicitation.

HG Construction Development & Investment did not provide a completed Contractor Assurance Statement form with the bid submittal. The firm was given three (3) business days to provide a completed Contractor Assurance Statement form as required by the solicitation. HG Construction Development & Investment did not submit the document within the allotted timeframe and therefore, the firm is not compliant with the CBE program requirements of the solicitation.
