I. REQUEST: Provide a description of the features of the product/service or Scope of Work.

The Records, Taxes and Treasury Division (RTT) is requesting approval to negotiate a Renewal Amendment to the Agreement with Granicus, Inc., for continued software support and maintenance services of the Granicus Legislative Management and Government Transparency Suite of application software and related services, as a Most Reasonable Source. The County has been utilizing software and managed services from Granicus since 2010. This application allows for the online publishing and captioning of the Board of County Commissioners' meetings, the seamless integration of the Board Agenda workflow and creation processes, and provides a boards and commissions management application for integration of advisory boards and commissions. In addition, the application performs meeting management, storage, indexing and integration with external data repositories such as Municode. All of the applications are proprietary to and thus available only directly from Granicus. There are no resellers or channel partners available in the marketplace. Given the history of County use of the software and the tight integration across the various Granicus products, this is the Most Reasonable Source from which to procure such an application solution.
