THE RESOLUTION OF BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, LEVYING LAND CLEARANCE LIENS AGAINST CERTAIN DESCRIBED **PROPERTIES** IN UNINCORPORATED BROWARD COUNTY FOR NONPAYMENT OF LAND **PURSUANT** CLEARANCE COSTS CHAPTER TO OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE ORDINANCES: PROVIDING FOR THE ACCRUAL **CHARGES** INTEREST AND **FOR ADMINISTRATIVE** COSTS; PROVIDING FOR RECORDATION IN THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF BROWARD COUNTY; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on August 24, 1999, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida, enacted Ordinance No. 99-45, requiring the abatement of violations relating to land clearance in unincorporated areas of Broward County;

WHEREAS, notices of violations of Chapter 39, Article X, of the Broward County Code of Ordinances (the "Code"), were provided to the owners of the individual properties listed on Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof, notifying the owners that said properties were required to be brought into compliance with Chapter 39, Article X, of the Code (the "Property Maintenance Ordinance"), by correcting the violations detailed in the notices of violation;

WHEREAS, the property owners have failed, neglected, or refused to have their respective property cleared of weeds, debris, or noxious materials as required by the Property Maintenance Ordinance; Notices of Noncompliance of the land clearance violations were recorded in the public records of Broward County, Florida; Broward
