Section 2. Administrative Action by the County Administrator.

The agreements with the service providers identified in Attachment A will be renewed for FY22 in accordance with the terms and conditions of the agreements. Upon receipt of the full grant award, the Broward County Administrator is hereby authorized to take all necessary administrative and budgetary actions to implement the agreements. Nothing in this Resolution alters the requirement that agreements be reviewed for legal sufficiency by the Office of the County Attorney before execution. Any material deviations from the applicable Board-approved form agreement must be presented to the Board for approval.

Section 3. Severability.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.
