WHEREAS, the Board further desires to authorize the Broward County Administrator ("County Administrator") to execute, on behalf of the County, amendments to existing agreements with the specified providers for services for Broward County youth who are experiencing mental health conditions and those at risk of involvement or involved in the juvenile justice system who are experiencing mental health conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that these services benefit the residents of Broward

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. <u>Authorized Appropriation and Disbursement.</u>

The Board hereby authorizes appropriation and disbursement of FY22 funds in the aggregate amount of Eight Hundred Thirty-five Thousand Dollars (\$835,000), as set forth in Attachment A.

Section 2. <u>Execution by the County Administrator</u>.

The County Administrator is hereby authorized to execute amendments effective October 1, 2021, increasing funding of existing agreements with each of the service providers, as specified in Attachment A. The County Administrator is further authorized to take all necessary administrative and budgetary actions to implement the agreements as amended. Nothing in this Resolution alters the requirement that agreements be reviewed for legal sufficiency by the Office of the County Attorney before execution. Any material deviations from the applicable Board-approved form agreement must be presented to the Board for approval.

Section 3. <u>Severability</u>.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.
