Wright, NOW, 21 THEREFORE 22 23 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF 24 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board hereby waives the provisions of Section 18.43(c) of the
 Administrative Code in order to consider renaming the County Road in honor of Judge
 Zebedee Wright and the late Dr. Kathleen C. Wright.
