A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, WAIVING SECTION 18.43(C) OF THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE TO CONSIDER NAMING A COUNTY-OWNED ROAD AFTER JUDGE ZEBEDEE WRIGHT, A LIVING PERSON, AND DR. KATHLEEN C. WRIGHT; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 18.43 of the Broward County Administrative Code (“Administrative Code”) sets out the policy of the Board of County Commissioners (“Board”) for naming property owned by Broward County (“County”);

WHEREAS, Section 18.43(c) of the Administrative Code provides that property owned by the County, including County roads, should not be named after living persons;

WHEREAS, Judge Zebedee Wright (“Judge Wright”) is a living person who has made numerous significant contributions to the County, including as a civil rights attorney and Broward County Court Judge; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to waive the provisions of Section 18.43(c) of the Administrative Code in order to consider renaming the portion of NW 6th Court from NW 27th Avenue to NW 31st Avenue located in the Broward Municipal Services District (“County Road”) in honor of Judge Wright and the late Dr. Kathleen C. Wright, NOW,
