The used oil and used oil filters' secondary containment units were also found to be inadequate. A short-form Consent Order was signed and \$2,500 in penalties were paid. The violations were corrected, and the case was closed on October 30, 2018. During the reporting period, two notices of violation were issued by the Miami-Dade Department of Environmental Resources Management to the Cliff Berry, Inc., Miami, FL facility for objectionable odors emanating from the facility into the surrounding neighborhoods. Cliff Berry, Inc. submitted an Air Quality Monitoring Plan and replaced tanks and equipment to minimize air emissions. On

March 28, 2018, the FDEP issued a Notice of Violation to the Fort Lauderdale, FL facility for omitting the source of used oil indicating the name and address and the EPA identification number on used oil

transport documentation. The documentation was re-submitted with the required information. On July 16, 2018, the Broward County Water and Wastewater Operations Division issued a Notice of Violation for exceedance of the allowed maximum concentrations of iron, lead and zinc in wastewater dumped into the Broward County Septage Receiving Facility. A penalty of \$596.86 was assessed and paid on August 13, 2018.

Environmental Violations: On May 28, 2019, several violations were found during an inspection of Crowley's facility at Port Everglades by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection ("FDEP"). Crowley was found to be acting as an unpermitted Waste Treatment, Storage and Disposal Facility, by exceeding the 10-day storage limit for transfer facilities of hazardous waste. A lapse in registration status from November 30, 2018 to May 9, 2019, was identified and potential non-compliance issues related to storage and labeling of containers of used oil were found. A meeting to resolve the pending issues was conducted on December 17, 2019. No penalties have been assessed at this time. A follow-up meeting will be scheduled in March 2020, after FDEP's internal review of Crowley's corrective actions is completed.

A penalty of \$1,500 was assessed and paid. Host Agency, LLC took corrective action by re-training their employees to review all paperwork with the manager prior to filing. On January 14, 2019, a notice of violation was issued for failure to report a diversion of a ship sailing from Port Everglades, permitted to Port Arthur, TX, but diverted to Houston, TX, due to flooding at the facility where the cargo was to be delivered. The \$5,000 penalty was mitigated to \$500 and was paid in December 2019.
