5 Section 1. The Plan is hereby amended by Amendment 20-T4, which is an  
6 amendment to the Broward County Comprehensive Plan text related to the Water  
7 Management Element.

8 Section 2. Severability.

9 If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any Court to be invalid, the invalid  
10 portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the remainder of  
11 this Ordinance. If any Court determines that this Ordinance, or any portion hereof, cannot  
12 be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies), property(ies), or  
13 circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability hereof to any other  
14 individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

15 Section 3. Effective Date.

16 (a) The effective date of the plan amendment set forth in this Ordinance will be  
17 the latter of:

18 (1) Thirty-one (31) days after the Department of Economic Opportunity notifies  
19 Broward County that the plan amendment package is complete;

20 (2) If the plan amendment is timely challenged, the date a final order is issued  
21 by the Administration Commission or the Department of Economic Opportunity finding the  
22 amendment to be in compliance; or

23 (3) If the Department of Economic Opportunity or the Administration  
24 Commission finds the amendment to be in noncompliance, pursuant to
