6	DIVISION; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN
7	EFFECTIVE DATE.
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9	WHEREAS, the division of Broward Water and Wastewater Services responsible for
10	overseeing accounts, revenues, and fiscal policy operates under the name "Water and
11	Wastewater Business Operations Division" (the "Division");
12	WHEREAS, the Broward County Administrative Code ("Administrative Code")
13	currently references an outdated name for the Division;
14	WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") wishes to receive
15	reports, on a quarterly basis, regarding all credits, adjustments, and payment arrangements
16	issued or made by the Division; and
17	WHEREAS, the Board finds it is reasonable and in the best interest of the public to
18	revise Part XV and Sections 6.72 and 6.73 of Chapter 6 of the Administrative Code to
19	reflect the current name of the Division, and to require quarterly reporting to the Board
20	effective on or after October 1, 2020, NOW, THEREFORE,
21	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
22	BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:
23	Section 1. The recitals set forth in the preamble to this Resolution are
24	incorporated by reference herein.
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Section 2. Part XV and Sections 6.72 and 6.73 of Chapter 6 of the Administrative
 Code are hereby amended to read as follows:

PART XV. WATER AND WASTEWATER FISCAL <u>BUSINESS</u> OPERATIONS DIVISION
6.72. Water and Wastewater Fiscal <u>Business</u> Operations Division Established;
5 Director as Head.

6 There is hereby established a Water and Wastewater Fiscal <u>Business</u> Operations 7 Division <u>which that shall</u> be responsible for <u>fiscal the business</u> operations of Water and 8 Wastewater Services. The Water and Wastewater <u>Fiscal Business</u> Operations Director shall 9 have a degree from an accredited four-year college or university in accounting, business or 10 public administration, or a related field with several years of progressively responsible 11 management experience, or any equivalent combination of training and experience.

12 6.73. Functions; Responsibilities.

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The Water and Wastewater Fiscal Business Operations Division shall:

- 14 a. Manage and direct the fiscal <u>business</u> operations of Water and Wastewater
  15 Services.
- b. Develop and maintain accounts and accounting systems to provide
  management information to Water and Wastewater Services' divisions.
  Provide appropriate and timely interim and annual financial reports for those
  funds comprising Water and Wastewater Services. Collect, deposit, and
  account for Water and Wastewater Services' funds.
- c. Develop and maintain sound fiscal policies to implement capital programs
   and fund operations. Recommend and develop financial terms and conditions
   for agreements and contracts and manage bond programs and other financial
   responsibilities. Develop financing plans, rates, fees, and charges for services

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provided by Water and Wastewater Services including, but not limited to,
 retail utility services, regional water, and regional wastewater services.
 d. Maintain records of revenues and expenditures and prepare financial
 documents and reports when appropriate for federal and state governmental

- e. Coordinate the preparation and completion of budget reports, including
  requested budget, approved budget and budget comparative reports, as well
  as coordinating coordinate all interim budget amendments or adjustments for
  Water and Wastewater Services.
- f. Define and implement systems and procedures for customer service
  activities, including but not limited to initiating service, billing and collection for
  services provided, and termination of service in accordance with County
  ordinances and resolutions.

14g.Establish, as part of the billing and collection process, policies and15procedures for issuing credits and adjustments to customer accounts and for16establishing payment arrangements for customers with delinquent accounts,17with such policies and procedures to include reporting of all credits,18adjustments, and payment arrangements on a quarterly basis to the Board of19County Commissioners.

20 Section 3. <u>Severability</u>.

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If any portion of this Administrative Code Resolution is determined by any Court to

 property, or circumstance.

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## Section 4. Inclusion in the Broward County Administrative Code.

5 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this 6 Administrative Code Resolution become part of the Broward County Administrative Code as 7 of the effective date. The sections of this Administrative Code Resolution may be 8 renumbered or relettered and the word "resolution" may be changed to "section," "article," 9 or such other appropriate word or phrase to the extent necessary in order to accomplish 10 such intention.

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Section 5. <u>Effective Date</u>.
