9	<u>d.</u>	Possesses a valid Florida driver license issued under Chapter 322,	
10		Florida Statutes, and a valid Broward County chauffeur's registration;	
11	<u>e.</u>	Is trained in the safe operation of ambulances, and has completed	
12		an emergency vehicle operator's course or the reasonable
