CBE Compliance Comments:

National Fire Protection, LLC. and Black Fire Protection, Inc. are compliant with the CBE program requirements of the solicitation. The firms did not provide executed LOIs with the bid package. The firms were given three (3) business days to provide their CBE goal commitment or documentation to support their good faith efforts to meet the CBE goal requirements. The firms provided executed LOIs for CBE participation within the required three (3) day period.

Advanced Systems, Inc. is not in compliance with the CBE program requirements of the solicitation. The firm did not provide an executed LOI with the bid package. The firm was given three (3) business days to provide completed LOIs and/or supporting documentation demonstrating their good faith efforts to meet the goal. Advanced Systems, Inc. submitted a completed Application for Evaluation of Good Faith Efforts within the three (3) day period. However, the firm did not provide additional supporting documentation for evaluation of their good faith efforts in accordance with Section 1-81.5 (d)(2) of the Broward County Business Opportunity Act of 2012 (the "Act") as amended. Therefore, OESBD has determined that Advanced Systems, Inc. has not met the quality, quantity and extent in their various efforts to meet the established goal in accordance with Section 1-81.5 (d)(2) of the "Act".
