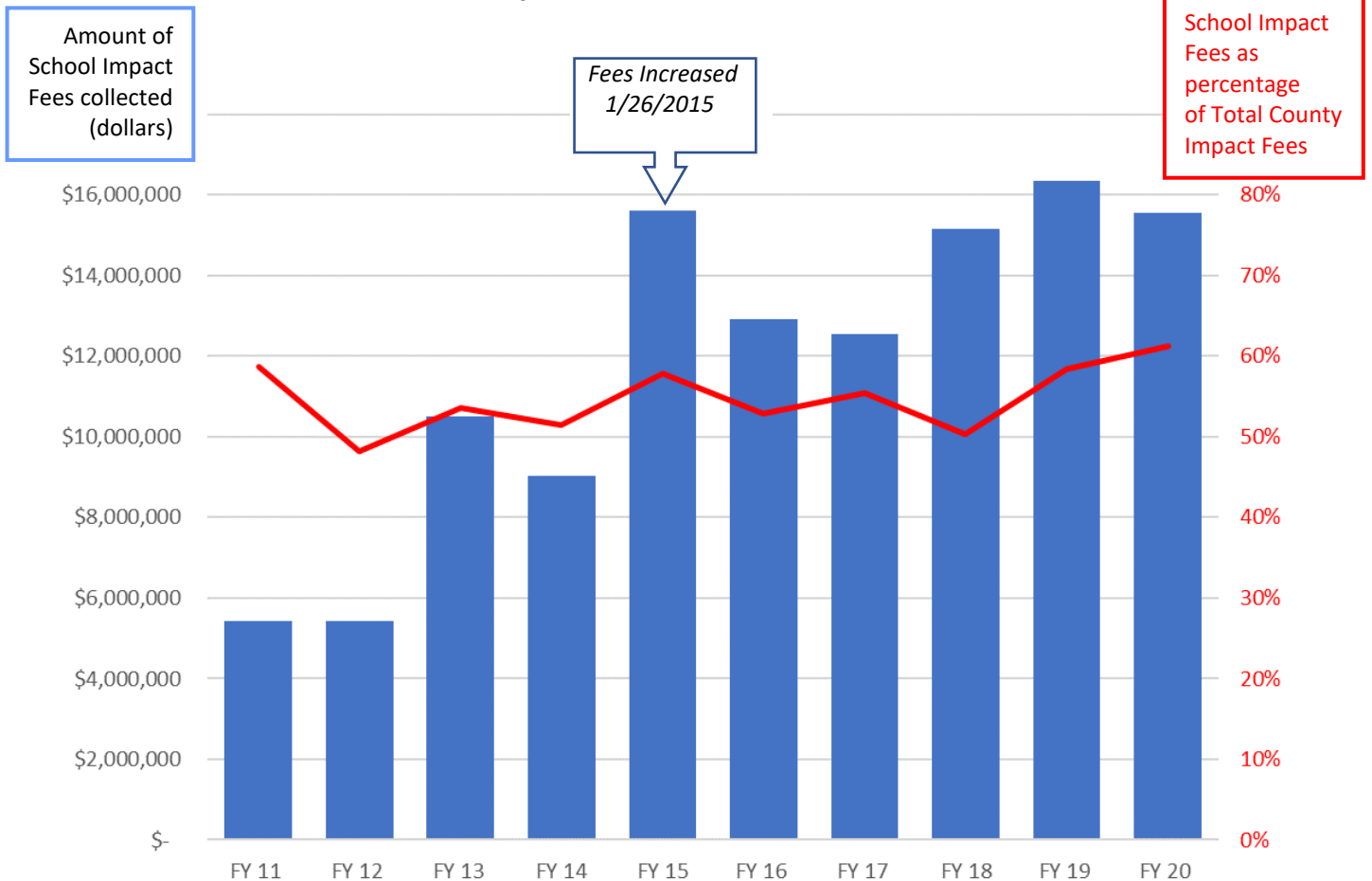

**School Impact Fees**

Broward County assesses impact fees for public schools, transportation, roads, and recreation/parks, consistent with the Broward County Land Development Code. Over the past ten years, \$215 million in School Impact Fees have been collected on behalf of the Broward County School Board. In FY 2020, the amount collected was \$15.6 million, which accounted for 61 percent of all impact fees paid, as shown in the chart below.
