

RESOLUTION NO. 22-200

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT AMONG BROWARD COUNTY, THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, AND THE FORT LAUDERDALE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY FOR THE NORTHEAST 4TH AVENUE COMPLETE STREET PROJECT IN THE CENTRAL CITY COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AREA; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 11, 2017, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 17-132 supporting and authorizing the submittal of an application for a Broward Redevelopment Program ("BRP") grant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort of Fort Lauderdale ("City") and the Fort Lauderdale Community Redevelopment Agency ("CRA") submitted a joint BRP grant program application for the Northeast 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue Complete Street Project in the Central City Community Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, on March 5, 2019, the Broward County Commission awarded the City and CRA funding in the amount of \$1,000,000 for this improvement project which will consist of streetscape enhancements, new and wider sidewalks including Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA ramps, pedestrian scale street lighting, shade trees, among other design and enhanced features); and

WHEREAS, on December 3, 2019, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale approved the Interlocal Agreement between Broward County, the City, and CRA; and

WHEREAS, on December 31, 2022, the current Interlocal Agreement will terminate and the Parties desire to extend the termination date until December 31, 2024;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby approves a First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement between Broward County, the City, and CRA, in substantially the form attached as Exhibit 3 to the Commission Agenda Memorandum


