ა 4	FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR A REFERENDUM ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2022, THE DATE OF THE GENERAL ELECTION, TO		
5	DETERMINE WHETHER TO AMEND THE BROWARD COUNTY CHARTER TO ESTABLISH A TWO-YEAR		
6	TERM OF OFFICE FOR THE BROWARD COUNTY MAYOR AND TO INCREASE THE MAYOR'S SALARY; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN		
7	EFFECTIVE DATE.		
8	(Sponsored by Senator Steve Geller)

10	WHEREAS, Section 2.06 of the Broward County Charter ("Charter") authorizes the		
11	Broward County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") to propose amendments and		
12	revisions to the Charter, subject to referendum of the general electorate; and		
13	WHEREAS, the Board desires to place a referendum before the voters at the		
14	November 8, 2022, General Election that, if approved, would amend the Broward County		
15	Charter to provide that the Broward County Mayor is elected by the Board every two years		
16	instead of annually and would increase the Mayor's salary by 50%, NOW, THEREFORE,

18	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF		
19	BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:		
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21	Section 1. Effective November 19, 2024, and subject to an affirmative vote of		
22	the general electorate, Section 2.01 of the Charter of Broward County, Florida, titled		
23	"Composition, redistricting, terms, qualifications, and compensation of members," is		
24	hereby amended to read as follows:		
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# Sec. 2.01. Composition, redistricting, terms, qualifications, and compensation of members.

Coding:

D. The Commissioners' salaries Except as to the Mayor, a Commissioner's salary shall be determined and established in accordance with the general law of the State of Florida pertaining to salary and compensation for Commissioners of non-charter counties. The Mayor's salary shall be 150% of a Commissioner's salary. Commissioners shall only be reimbursed for expenses that are specifically approved by the County Commission, and when properly incurred on County business, in conformance with the laws of the State of Florida.

Section 2. Effective November 19, 2024, and subject to an affirmative vote of the general electorate, Section 2.03 of the Charter of Broward County, Florida, titled "Commission election of Mayor and Vice-Mayor," is hereby amended to read as follows:

### Sec. 2.03. Commission election of Mayor and Vice-Mayor

- A. The County Commission shall elect one (1) Commissioner to the position of Mayor for a two-year term by a majority vote. The election of the Mayor shall occur on an annual basis, even numbered years during the County Commission's annual organizational meeting, which shall take place no earlier than the third Tuesday of each November and no later than the third Tuesday of each December. The County Commission may remove the individual from the position of Mayor by a majority vote. The Mayor may serve consecutive terms.
- B. Following the election of the Mayor, tThe County Commission shall elect a Commissioner to the position of Vice-Mayor for a one-year term by a majority vote. The

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election of the Vice-Mayor shall occur on an annual basis during the County Commission's annual organizational meeting. In the Mayor's absence, the Vice-Mayor shall have all the rights, privileges, and duties of the Mayor. The County Commission may remove the individual from the position of Vice-Mayor by a majority vote. The Vice-Mayor may serve consecutive terms.

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Section 3. A referendum election is called for the General Election on November 8, 2022, and at such other times as permitted for voting under Chapter 101, Florida Statutes, to determine whether the Broward County Charter should be amended to provide that the Broward County Mayor is elected by the Board to a two-year term with an increased salary.

Section 4. In accordance with Section 100.342, Florida Statutes, at least thirty (30) days' notice of the referendum election shall be published by the Broward County Administrator in a newspaper of general circulation in Broward County. The publication shall be made at least twice, including once in the fifth week and once in the third week prior to the week in which the referendum is to be held. The notice is hereby attached as Exhibit A and made a part hereof.

Section 5. Said referendum election shall be held between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on November 8, 2022, and at such other days and times as provided under applicable law, including for early voting as provided by Section 101.657, Florida Statutes, at the polling places established in Broward County. All registered and qualified electors in Broward County shall be eligible to vote in the referendum election. Vote-by-mail ballots and early voting access for the referendum shall be made available as provided by law.

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Section 6. The election boards consisting of the clerks and inspectors appointed to serve for the November 8, 2022, General Election are hereby appointed to serve in the referendum election in the manner provided by law.

Section 7. The Broward County Canvassing Board shall canvass the returns in said election and shall certify the results of the referendum election as provided by law.

Section 8. The County Administrator shall furnish a certified copy of this adopted Resolution to the Supervisor of Elections for Broward County promptly upon adoption by the Board.

Section 9. The title and summary of the referendum question to appear on the November 8, 2022, General Election, as embodied in this enabling Resolution, shall be as follows:

NOTICE OF REFERENDUM ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2022, THE DATE OF THE GENERAL ELECTION, TO DETERMINE WHETHER TO DETERMINE WHETHER TO AMEND THE BROWARD COUNTY CHARTER TO ESTABLISH A TWO-YEAR TERM OF OFFICE FOR THE BROWARD COUNTY MAYOR AND TO INCREASE THE MAYOR'S SALARY.

A countywide referendum election will be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, and at such other times as provided for by Chapter 101, Florida Statutes, for the purpose of determining whether to amend the Broward County Charter to provide for a two-year term of office and an increased salary for the Broward County Mayor.

As set forth in enabling Resolution No. 2022-\_\_\_\_, adopted on \_\_\_\_, by the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida, the title and summary to appear on the referendum ballot shall be as follows:

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The referendum shall be held on November 8, 2022, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., and at such other days and times as provided under applicable law, including for early voting as provided by Section 101.657, Florida Statutes, at the

polling places established in Broward County. All registered and qualified electors of Broward County shall be eligible to vote in said referendum election. Vote-by-mail ballots for the referendum election shall be prepared and made available as provided by law.

The Broward County Canvassing Board shall canvass the returns and certify the results of the referendum election to the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida, the Broward County Administrator, and the Florida Department of State, to be recorded and filed in appropriate public records.
