RESOLUTION NO. 2021-1 RESOLUTION THE **BOARD** OF COUNTY 2 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, IN SUPPORT OF THE COOPERATIVE FOR ASSISTANCE 3 AND RELIEF **EVERYWHERE** ("CARE' INTERNATIONAL **HUMANITARIAN** ORGANIZATION 4 DEDICATED TO FIGHTING POVERTY AND PROMOTING SOCIAL JUSTICE ACROSS THE GLOBE; AND PROVIDING 5 FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 6 (Sponsored by Commissioner Barbara Sharief) 7 8 WHEREAS, 820 million people around the world will go to bed hungry tonight, and an additional 2 billion people do not know where their next meal is coming from; 10 WHEREAS, according to demographic data compiled by the Broward County Planning and Development Management Division, fourteen percent (14%) of Broward 11 12 County residents live below the poverty line, including more than nineteen percent (19%) 13 of children under the age of eighteen (18) in Broward County; 14 WHEREAS, the Cooperative for Assistance and Relief Everywhere ("CARE") is an 15 international humanitarian organization dedicated to fighting poverty and promoting social 16 justice across the globe; 17 WHEREAS, CARE has introduced certain poverty-fighting initiatives to its United 18 States operations, such as the CARE Community Lending Circles to provide financial 19 stability and economic opportunities to break the cycle of poverty; 20 WHEREAS, through its CARE Package Relief program, CARE provides critical 21 food and services to vulnerable communities through partnerships with gig economy 22 platforms such as TaskRabbit, Lyft, and DoorDash; under this program, CARE has delivered millions of meals to food-insecure populations and put \$350,000 directly in
