Planning Council staff has reviewed the proposed revision to the restrictive note on the above referenced plat.

The Future Land Use Element of the City of Pompano Beach Comprehensive Plan is the effective land use plan for the City of Pompano Beach. That plan designates the area covered by this plat for the uses permitted in the "Low-Medium 5-10 DU/AC" land use category. This plat is generally located on the north side of Martin Luther King Boulevard/Hammondville Road, between Powerline Road and Andrews Avenue Extension.

The existing and proposed day care and health center uses are in compliance with the permitted uses of the effective land use plan.

The density of the proposed development of 602 dwelling units on 82.95 acres of land in the platted area, including the immediately adjacent rights-of-way, is 7.26 dwelling units per gross acre, which is in compliance with the permitted uses and densities of the effective land use plan.

The contents of this memorandum are not a judgment as to whether this development proposal complies with the Broward County Trafficways Plan, local zoning, other land development regulations or the development review requirements of the Broward County Land Use Plan including its concurrency requirements.
