VI. SUMMARY DESCRIPTION:

The Broward Sheriff's Office supports this LETF for matching funds for the BSO Criminal Investigations Division. BSO receives a grant from the Florida Office of Attorney General in the amount of 81,284.00 to fund one full time Victim Advocate position in the Special Victims Unit for a one year grant period (Oct.1, 2020-Sep.30, 2021). As a condition of the grant award and to fully fund the position/program we are requesting LETF funds in the amount of \$38,985.00 to be used as matching funds. The VOCA funded Victim Advocate will provide services to victims of all crimes against persons, including simple and aggravated battery, whose victims are typically underserved as those crimes don't often reach the same level of attention. This Advocate typically serves 400 victims annually.
