Proposed Second Amendment: The CBE commitment remains 15%.

The purpose of the second amendment to the second addendum to the Signatory Terminal Building Lease Agreement (TBLA) is to decrease the contract term by 212 days and the second Addendum amount by \$67,000,000.00.

- Amount of Proposed Second Amendment: (\$67,000,000.00)
- Revised Contract Amount through Proposed Second Amendment to the Second addendum: \$153,000,000.00

CBE Compliance Comments:

Delta committed to utilizing CBE firms to perform 15% of the overall project. The current level of CBE participation under the agreement is 13.04%. This represents a participation shortfall of 1.96%. The shortfall is attributed to the prime vendor not being able to count the participation of one of its CBE-certified vendors, which was deemed by OESBD to not have been performing a commercially useful function. Additionally, the prime vendor terminated one of its non-CBE-certified subcontractors, which was anticipated to have a lower-tiered CBE-certified subcontractor working under it, for non-performance. The lower-tier CBE firm was terminated by default when the non-CBE upper-tier subcontractor was terminated by the prime vendor. The combined subcontract amounts of these two CBE vendors was one million seven hundred sixty-eight thousand six hundred dollars (\$1,768,600.00).

OESBD confirmed with the prime vendor that, of the remaining scope under the contract, there are required services estimated at eight million dollars (\$8 million) that can be subcontracted. Additionally, the prime vendor states that there is remaining change order work, which has not

yet been priced, which it intends to directly subcontract to CBE subcontractors to ensure that the fifteen percent (15%) participation commitment is realized at the time of project completion. OESBD will continue to monitor this contract for compliance with the CBE Program and monitor the good faith efforts being made to meet the participation commitment.
