Section 1-6 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, entitled 19 "Purchase of uniforms by county for certain employees," is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. Section 1-8 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, entitled
"Expenditures and budgeting for purpose of public information on energy crisis," is hereby
repealed in its entirety.

23 Section 3. Section 1-12 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, entitled
24 "Electronic access to public records," is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 4. Section 1-20 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, entitled
"Execution by commission of agreements with second parties," is hereby repealed in its
entirety.

Section 5. Section 1-21 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, entitled
"Time limitation on bringing matters before the board of county commissioners," is hereby
repealed in its entirety.

Section 6. Section 1-46 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, entitled
"Indemnification clauses in federal project contracts, etc.," is hereby repealed in its
entirety.

Section 7. Severability.

If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
Ordinance. If any court determines that this Ordinance, in whole or in part, cannot be
legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
determination will not affect the applicability of this Ordinance to any other individual,
group, entity, property, or circumstance.

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Section 8. Inclusion in the Broward County Code of Ordinances.

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this
Ordinance become part of the Broward County Code of Ordinances as of the effective
date. The sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word
