RESOLUTION NO. 2021-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, DESIGNATING A PORTION OF NORTHWEST ELEVENTH STREET IN THE BROWARD MUNICIPAL SERVICES DISTRICT ("COUNTY ROAD") AS "PANTHER LANE"; DIRECTING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ANY NECESSARY ACTIONS TO EFFECTUATE THE RENAMING OF THE COUNTY ROAD; DIRECTING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO PROVIDE A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE OFFICIALS DESIGNATED HEREIN; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 18.43 of the Broward County Administrative Code ("Administrative Code") sets out the policy of the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") for naming property owned by Broward County ("County");

WHEREAS, that portion of NW 11th Street from NW 27th Avenue to NW 31st Avenue is a County-owned road located in the Broward Municipal Services District ("County Road");

WHEREAS, the adjoining portion of NW 11th Street between NW 23rd Avenue and NW 26th Avenue, which is in the City of Fort Lauderdale city limits, has the primary name of "Panther Lane;"

WHEREAS, the designation of the County Road as "Panther Lane" would serve to extend the portion of the right-of-way designated as "Panther Lane" to incorporate the County Road;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 336.05, Florida Statutes, the Board is authorized to name and rename County-owned streets and roads;

1 WHEREAS, on September 9, 2021 (Agenda Item No. 63), the Board (1) provided
2 notice on the record that the Board would consider the proposed designation of the
3 County Road as required by Section 18.43(h) of the Administrative Code; and (2) directed
4 the County Administrator to solicit the input of at least three local municipalities,
5 homeowners' associations, or community groups of the Board's proposed renaming of
6 the County Road, which correspondence is attached hereto as Attachment 1; and

7 WHEREAS, the Board desires to designate County Road as "Panther Lane,"
8 NOW, THEREFORE,

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
11 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

13 Section 1. The Board hereby renames the County Road as "Panther Lane." In
14 accordance with Section 18.43(g) of the Administrative Code, the current name of the
15 County Road shall be retained as a secondary designation.

16 Section 2. The Board directs the County Administrator to take all budgetary and
17 other actions necessary to effectuate the renaming of the County Road as "Panther
18 Lane."

19 Section 3. The Board further directs the County Administrator, as Clerk of the
20 Board, to transmit a copy of this Resolution to the United States Postal Service, the
21 Broward County Highway Construction and Engineering Division, the Broward County
22 Sheriff's Office, and the Broward County Sheriff's Office Department of Fire Rescue.

1 Section 4. Severability.

2 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
3 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
4 Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be
5 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
6 determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,
7 group, entity, property, or circumstance.

8 Section 5. Effective Date.

9 This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
