

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
3 COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO WASTEWATER SERVICES; AMENDING
4 SECTION 38.20 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE
5 ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE"), TO PRESCRIBE A REVISED SCHEDULE OF
6 WASTEWATER LARGE USER RATES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY,
7 INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

9 WHEREAS, Broward County provides transmission, treatment, and disposal
10 sewer services to large users of Broward County's North Regional Wastewater Treatment
11 and Transmission Facility pursuant to certain Agreements (the "Agreements");

12 WHEREAS, the Agreements require that Broward County review the rates on an
13 annual basis, and Broward County has completed its review accordingly;

14 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34-6 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances,
15 the water and wastewater rates, fees, and charges are required to be established
16 following public notice and hearing, which, in this matter, have been satisfied; and

17 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds it is reasonable and in the
18 best interest of the public to revise Section 38.20 of the Broward County Administrative
19 Code to reflect the new rates, fees, and charges for large users of the North Regional
20 Wastewater Treatment and Transmission Facility effective with all services rendered on
21 or after October 1, 2022, NOW, THEREFORE,

22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
23 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

24 Section 1. The recitals set forth in the preamble to this Resolution are
25 incorporated by reference herein.

26 Section 2. Section 38.20 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby
27 amended to read as follows:

28 **38.20. Wastewater Large User Rates.**

29 The following schedule of rates, fees, and charges for Large Users of the North
30 Regional Wastewater System operated by Broward County Water and Wastewater
31 Services is effective with all services rendered on or after October 1, ~~2021~~ 2022:
