9	WHEREAS, as required by Section 2-3 of the Broward County Code of
10	Ordinances, the Broward County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") establishes,
11	through the adoption of a Resolution, the rates, fees, and charges for the services and
12	facilities provided at Broward County's Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport
13	("Airport");
14	WHEREAS, the rates, fees, and charges for services and facilities at the Airport
15	are included in Chapter 39 of the Broward County Administrative Code; and
16	WHEREAS, the Board desires to amend certain provisions of Chapter 39 in order
17	to revise the schedule of rates, fees, and charges, NOW, THEREFORE,

### III. FACILITY USE CHARGE

A Facility Use Charge of twelve eleven dollars and twenty cents (\$12.20) (\$11.20) per deplaning passenger is hereby established for incoming international flights utilizing the federal inspection station for taking on or discharging passengers.

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#### NOTES:

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(5) All passenger check-in facilities must be reserved in advance, with the approval of the Aviation Department. Passenger check-in facilities charges shall be applied at the rate of thirty-six dollars (\$36.00) twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per hour, or any part thereof, for Signatory Carriers, and forty-seven dollars (\$47.00) thirty-three dollars (\$33.00) per hour, or any part thereof, for all other carriers, per ticket counter position for any passenger check-in facility reserved, whether utilized or not. Signatory Carriers will not be charged, on a monthly basis, for per use passenger check-in facilities in an amount greater than would otherwise be charged to that carrier for a monthly preferential lease of equivalent ticket counter space.

(8) Signatory Carriers using a per use gate shall not be charged more than the following amounts for Gate Charges for that gate, per month:

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this Administrative Code Resolution become part of the Broward County Administrative Code as of the effective date. The sections of this Administrative Code Resolution may be renumbered or relettered and the word "resolution" may be changed to "section," "article,"
